We love being able to make dreams come true for our residents at Newton House and ensure that they get to celebrate life every day



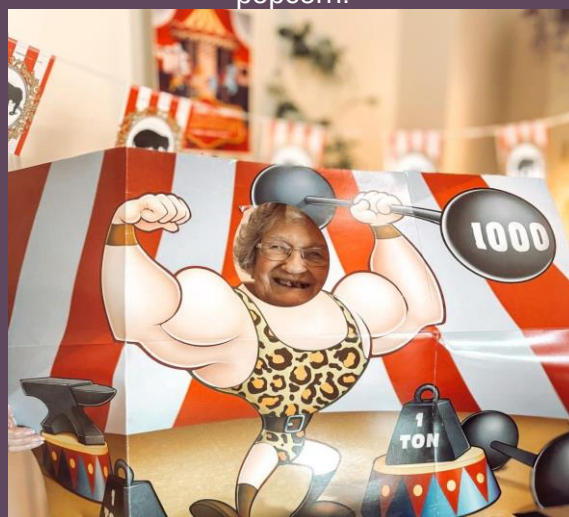
Roll up, Roll up...
