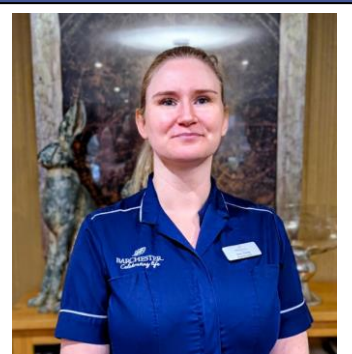

it's residents.

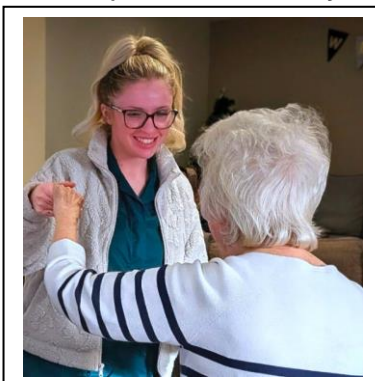
