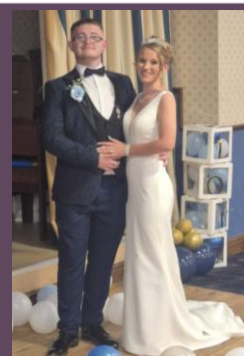
After over 22 years of service our Administrator Ann Retires
