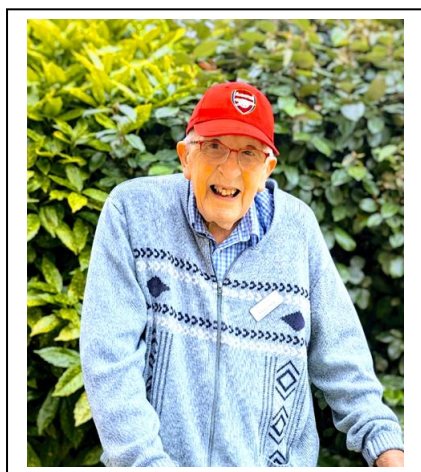


A word and introduction from our Resident Ambassador

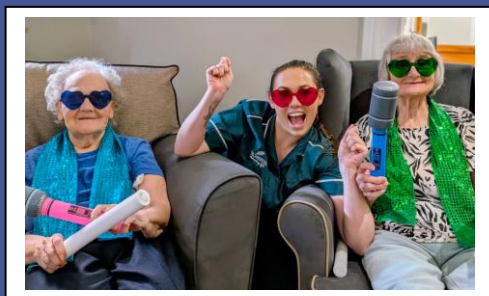
